Chemotherapy Waste Containers

Only empty syringes, ampules, vials and IV's may be placed into the chemotherapy containers, along with other trace contaminated paraphernalia, such as gowns, gloves, goggles, IV tubing and sharps. The EPA Resource Conservation and Recovery Act and Best Management Practices require bulk and residue chemotherapy waste to be disposed of as hazardous waste.

Special Medical Waste

Special waste includes pathological and chemotherapy wastes. Listed below are the specifics from Stericycle's waste acceptance protocol for the best management practices for medical waste. Remember that there are also state specific requirements.

Pathological Wastes:

- Includes tissue matter from humans or animals.
- Must be labeled accordingly and should be marked for incineration.

Chemotherapy Wastes:

- Includes needles, bags, tubing, containers, gloves, gowns, etc., with trace chemotherapy material. Trace means less than 3% by volume.
- Must not be P- or U-listed wastes under the EPA RCRA Hazardous Waste regulations.
- Bulk chemotherapy, i.e., full bags or bottles should be disposed of through a hazardous waste hauler.
- Must be labeled as chemotherapy and segregated and labeled for incineration.

Best Management Practices encourage the disposal of pharmaceuticals which are not hazardous waste by incineration at a permitted facility. They should not be placed into red sharps containers as these may be treated by methods other than incineration. Segregation into a dedicated nonhazardous pharmaceutical container ensures their disposal by incineration.

California Department of Public Health requires the segregation and incineration of waste pharmaceuticals that are not federally regulated under RCRA. These must be incinerated at a medical waste treatment facility.

Source segregation is very important. The EPA has identified a number of common pharmaceuticals and drug formulations as hazardous waste under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act. Among others, these pharmaceuticals must be segregated into toxic or ignitable hazardous waste containers as:

- P-listed drugs including epinephrine (adrenaline), nicotine, and warfarin
- U-listed drugs including cyclophosphamide, lindane, melphalan, and mitomycin C
- Pharmaceuticals containing heavy metals and mercury, such as vaccines, eye and ear drops containing thimerosal, and barium sulfate preparations

These also include ignitable hazardous wastes such as:

- Pharmaceuticals containing 24% or more alcohol like Cleocin T® Topical Solution, Retin A® Gel, and Taxol® Injection.



Cultures and Stock Waste (Formerly PGII) Containers

Cultures, sharps and stocks from your facility can be disposed of without the concern of leaks when using these containers.

RCRA (Hazardous) Waste Containers

Best Management Practices encourage the disposal of pharmaceuticals which are not hazardous waste by incineration at a permitted facility. Pharmaceuticals should not be placed into red sharps containers as these may be treated by methods other than incineration. Segregation into a dedicated nonhazardous pharmaceutical container ensures their disposal by incineration. California Department of Public Health requires the segregation and incineration of waste pharmaceuticals that are not federally regulated under RCRA. These must be incinerated at a medical waste treatment facility.
